COVID-19

Thank you so much for your continued cooperation with regards to the COVID rules. We are so lucky to have such supportive parents. Thankfully some restrictions are now beginning to ease across the country but we must still remain cautious. Here is a reminder of some of the main messages:

- If a child or another member of your household displays symptoms i.e. a continuous new cough, high temperature or loss of taste or smell, they must go for a **full PCR COVID test** and self-isolate until they get their results.
- Please wear a mask in the playground at all times, as requested by Sefton.
- Please ensure only 1 adult enters the playground for pick up and drop off.
- Please use the designated gate allocated for your child.
- Please pick up and drop off at the designated time.
- Please do not congregate in groups to chat, particularly near the gates.

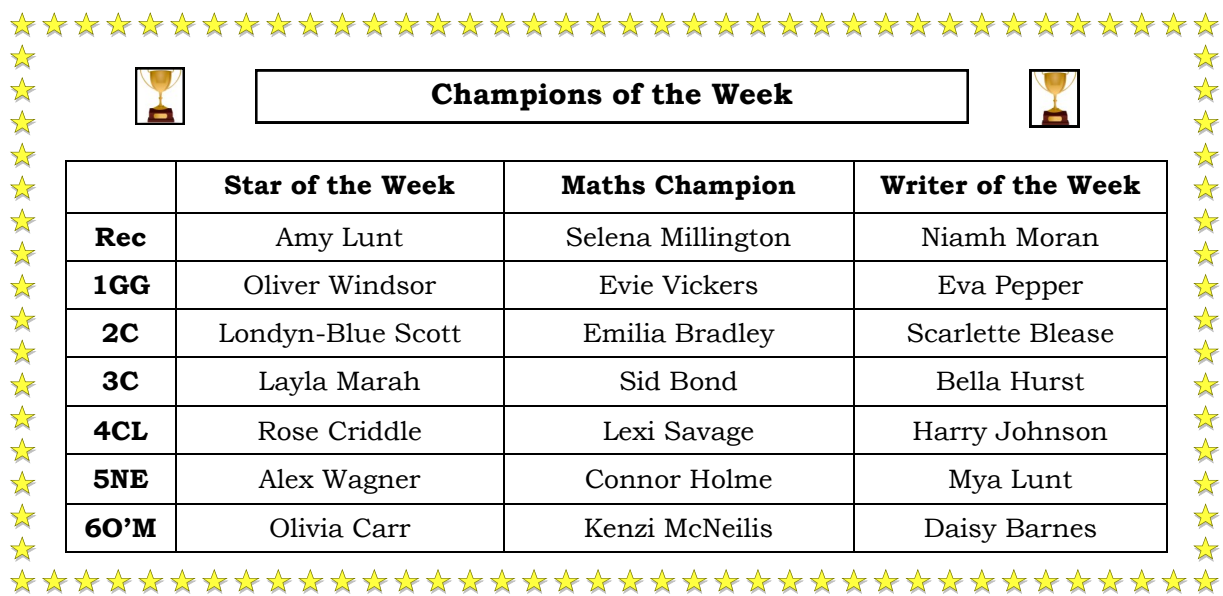
