Straws of different colours, scissors, Sellotape

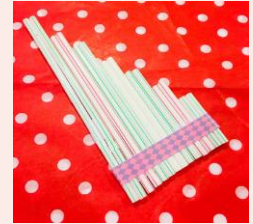
Cut each straw to a different length
